  - ✓ Even Maths and Science subjects that are thought to be "hard" can be a haven of peace if they meet a well prepared and committed teacher





- □ There are various ways of motivations, such as extrinsic and intrinsic.




## THE TEACHER'S KNOWLEDGE OF THE SUBJECT

- Commitment to teaching practice






